### **‘Grand Paris’**

**a project launched by the government to make the French capital a competitive metropolis on a world scale**

The Grand Paris Project is a "new comprehensive development project for Greater Paris" including an automated rail system circling Paris, with 80 new stations. It also represents a opportunity for economic growth by connecting 10 new suburban business centers (clusters) to the residential areas surrounding Paris.

This project is supposed to contribute to a new phase in the urban development focused on creating a city within a city, developing in a sustainable way and rethinking mobility. It would be realized by 2030.
